# First Year Fall Onboarding & Registration Tasks

**Mark your calendar for registration:**  
**Monday, July 20th at 10:00 am EST**

- Mid May: Activate your Lehigh account and email address**
- May - August: Complete tasks as outlined on your student admissions portal.**
- End of June: Website for First Year Enrollment Website goes live**  
This website is a resource for Fall registration planning: AP/Transfer credit info, ALEKS Calculus Placement Exam, Live Chat, FAQs, etc ([fys.enroll.lehigh.edu](https://fys.enroll.lehigh.edu))
- June - Mid July: Take [ALEKS Calculus Placement Exam](#)**  
If you did not receive AP/transfer credit for MATH 021, you are required to complete the ALEKS online assessment at least once before registration to determine your preparedness for calculus 1 at Lehigh. Can take the exam up to five times with 48 hours between each attempt
- Connect with your IBE advisor to plan for registration**  
Details on connecting with your IBE advisor will be sent to your Lehigh email by end of May
- By Mid June: [AP scores](#) and/or [official transcripts](#) must be sent to Registrar's office for evaluation ([ras@lehigh.edu](mailto:ras@lehigh.edu))**
- By Mid July: Accept the [Bursar Financial Responsibility](#) agreement**  
Accept agreement prior to day of registration or it will pop up before you can enter system and may cause delays
- Monday, July 20th @ 10:00 am EST: Registration opens**
